### **Lactation/Nurturing Rooms**

As a breast-feeding employee we hope to offer you support and assistance to enhance the success of your nursing experience. The lactation consultants are available to answer questions or assist as the need arises. You may reach them at extension 17103.

Bryan Medical Center has several Lactation/Nurturing Rooms which are available to any Bryan employee who is on duty and needs to do breast pumping while at work. Accessibility is via prox card entry, and employees who would like to have access should contact Employee Health at extension 18622 or your manager for a Prox Access Request to Biomed located on Hello.

#### **Lactation/Nurturing Rooms: Bryan Medical Center East**

- ▶ In Employee Health Services on the first floor. During clinic hours access is via the main entrance to EHS. After hours entrance to this room is via prox card and is located in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor south corridor.
- ▶ In the first floor hallway to the Women's and Children's tower. Just past the visitor elevators and directly across from the mother & baby gift shop is a room labeled "Nurturing Room".
- ▶ On 2<sup>nd</sup> floor hallway leading to the Emergency Department.
- ▶ 6<sup>th</sup> floor, 6 West, 2 rooms located in Respite Rooms.
- ▶ Plaza Surgery Locker Room

#### **Lactation/Nurturing Rooms: Bryan Medical Center West**

- ▶ In Employee Health Services on the seventh floor. During clinic hours access is via the main entrance to EHS. After hours entrance to this room is via prox card and is located in the 7 West corridor.
- ▶ Two rooms are located at the Bryan Medical West Plaza Tower B, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. Located at the top of the stairs on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Tower B (3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the parking garage). One is next to the seating area and the other is next to the museum.
- ▶ 2NW, at the entrance to the nursing unit, next to the public elevator and across from the clinical nurse specialist office.
- ▶ 7<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> floor by the patient care elevators
